A- Origen of Angels

Angels were created before Adam and existed at the time that Adam and Eve were placed in the garden (Gen 3:1, 24).

Job 38:6-7- Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? Or who laid the corner stone thereof; When the morning stars sang together, And all the sons of God shouted for joy... Thus at the laying of the foundation of the earth the angels were present.

There are two other names given to angels morning stars בּוֹבֵב בּבֶּר and also Sons of God (Gen 6:2; Job 1:6; 2:1). Satan who is the Devil is also referred to as Lucifer or Morning Star which would eclipse all the other stars (בֵּרֹב מִמְשַׁח בַּסוֹב) son of the Dawn (בְּרֹב מִמְשַׁח בַּסוֹב) Isa. 14:12; he is also called the שִׁלְּבֹר מִמְשַׁח בַּסוֹב לוֹב מִמְשַׁח בּרוֹב מִמְשַׁח בּסוֹב) who was in the Paradise of God Ezekiel 28:13-14 It would be during this age that Jesus referred to seeing Satan cast down as lightning "And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven." Luke 10:17-18

Finally they are referred to as the בא השׁמים heavenly host or host of heaven (Psalms 48:2) Psalms 148:2-5- Once again it is implied that God created the angels and the host before he created the Sun and the Moon and the stars

God created men lower than these divine ones מֵאֱלֹהִים (angels) Psalms 8:5. Once again indicating that men were created after the angels.

the actual word used in Psalms 8:5 is אֱלֹהָים it is translated "angel' because of context along with the fact that elohim can refer to angels as in the following examples:

1 Sam 28:13 And the king said unto her, Be not afraid: for what did you see? And the woman said unto Saul, I saw gods (אֱלֹהָים) ascending out of the earth.

God stands in the congregation of the mighty (5x);

He judges among the gods (אֱלֹהָים) . Ps 82:1

In that day shall the Lord defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; And he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; And the house of David shall be as God, As the angel of the Lord before them. (Zech 12:8)

B- Classifications Messagers

Angel of the Lord or Angel of God- found 131 times usually referring to the Lord Himself (Gen 16:10,13; 22:15; exodus 14:19; Numbers 20:16)

Referred to as: the power of διαβόλου "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities ἀρχάς,, against powers ἐξουσίας, against the rulers of the darkness κοσμοκράτορας τοῦ σκότους of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places πνευματικὰ τῆς πονηρίας ἐν τοῖς ἐπουρανίοις
