

## Angels and Demons

A- God refer to as an מלאך, and מלאך־יהוה Malachi 3:1; Gen 16:7; 18:14; 22:11; 31:11; Exodus 3:2; 23:20

Ge 16:9–14)

<sup>9</sup> And the angel of the Lord said unto her, Return to thy mistress, and submit thyself under her hands. <sup>10</sup> And the angel of the Lord said unto her, I will multiply thy seed exceedingly, that it shall not be numbered for multitude. <sup>11</sup> And the angel of the Lord said unto her, Behold, thou *art* with child, and shalt bear a son, and shalt call his name Ishmael; because the Lord hath heard thy affliction. <sup>12</sup> And he will be a wild man; his hand *will be* against every man, and every man's hand against him; and he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren. <sup>13</sup> And she called the name of the Lord that spake unto her, Thou God seest me: for she said, Have I also here looked after him that seeth me? <sup>14</sup> Wherefore the well was called "Beer-lahai-roi; (בְּאֵר לַחַי רֹאֵי) she had already said אֵל רֹאֵי

Ge 22:15–19

<sup>15</sup> And the angel of the Lord called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time, <sup>16</sup> And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the Lord, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only *son*: <sup>17</sup> **That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies;** <sup>18</sup> **And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.**

Ex 3:2–4

<sup>2</sup> And the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush *was* not consumed. <sup>3</sup> And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. <sup>4</sup> And when the Lord saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here *am* I.

Ex 32:34

<sup>34</sup> Therefore now go, lead the people unto *the place* of which I have spoken unto thee: behold, mine Angel shall go before thee: nevertheless in the day when I visit I will visit their sin upon them.

Ex 14:19

<sup>19</sup> And the angel of God, which went before the camp of Israel, removed and went behind them; and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them:

Ex 23:20-24

<sup>20</sup> Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared. <sup>21</sup> Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name *is* in him. <sup>22</sup> But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries. <sup>23</sup> For mine Angel shall go before thee, and bring thee in unto the Amorites, and the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Canaanites, *and* the Hivites, and the Jebusites: and I will cut them off. <sup>24</sup> Thou shalt not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do after their works: but thou shalt utterly overthrow them, and quite break down their images.

Malachi 3:1

**3** Behold, I will send my messenger (מַלְאָךְ), and he shall prepare the way before me: And the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, Even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: Behold, he shall come, saith the Lord of hosts.

B-The difference between a spirit (disembodied) and a spirit with a spirit body (Lk 24:39–42)

Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have. <sup>40</sup> And when he had thus spoken, he shewed them *his* hands and *his* feet. <sup>41</sup> And while they yet believed not for joy, and wondered, he said unto them, Have ye here any meat? <sup>42</sup> And they gave him a piece of a broiled fish, and of an honeycomb.
