

## 5- The works and deeds of Angels-

### A- Angels have the appearance of men

#### a- OT Examples

- 1- Lot- Gen 19:10
- 2- Jacob Gen 28:12 cr John 1:51
- 3- Elisha and his servant 2 Kings 6:15-17
- 4- Nebuchadnezzar Dan 3:24-25

#### b- NT Examples

- 1- Women at the tomb Luke 24:4; Matthew 28:2-3
- 2- Zacharias, Mary, Joseph, Disciples, Peter and John, Philip, Cornelius, Paul, John etc

### B- Angels are under the command of God the Father

a- And for this *cause* Hezekiah the king, and the prophet Isaiah the son of Amoz, prayed and cried to heaven. <sup>21</sup> And the Lord sent an angel, which cut off all the mighty men of valour, and the leaders and captains in the camp of the king of Assyria. 2 Chron 32:21

<sup>53</sup> Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels? Matthew 26:53

b- God is the Lord of Host - the commander of the angles of heaven Isa 1:9; 23:9; Jer: 23:36; Rev 22:6; 1 Chronicles 21:15; Gen 31:1-2

### C- Works and deeds of Angels

a- one angel slew 185,000 men (2 Kings 19:35)

b- announce good news (Jgs 13:3),

c- warn of danger (Gn 19:15),

d- guard from evil (Dan 3:28; 6:22),

e- bring revelation (Dan 8; 9:21; 10:5-21)

e- guide and protect (Ex 14:19), nourish (Gn 21:14-20; 1 Kgs 19:4-7),

f- instruct (Acts 7:38; Gal 3:19);

g- Jesus spoke about the guardian angels of little children (Mt 18:10).

h- Philip was guided by an angel (Acts 8:26).

i- Apostles were rescued from prison by an angel (Acts 5:19; 12:7-11).

j- In a frightening situation, the apostle Paul was encouraged by an angel (Acts 27:21-25).

k- Execute judgement- It was an angel who struck Herod Agrippa dead (Acts 12:21-23).
