

Lecture 6- Angels and Demons

6- Fallen Angels (Revelation 12:7–9)

a- Referred to as the Devil and His angels (Matthew 25:41)

b- Called the sons of God before their fall- Job 1:6-12; Gen 6:2,4; 2 Peter 2:4 ; Jude 6

2 Peter 2 ⁴ For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast *them* down to hell, and delivered *them* into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment

Jude ⁶ And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day

1- Their Fall- Is 14:12; Ez 28:13; Luke 10:18

12 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning!

How art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

13 For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven,

I will exalt my throne above the stars of God:

I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:

14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

15 Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

Luke 10:18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

2- Appearance

a- Physical spirit bodies which look like men and can interact with men, and be chained and bound in hell (Gen 6:2,4). They are also referred to as men (Jer 4).

b- Rev 9: 7 There only other appearance of angels that are uniquely different are those described coming up out of the pit that look like : And the shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men. 8 And they had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as the teeth of lions. 9 And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings was as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle.

3- Structure and activities

a-Satan is head over all of the angels of darkness and demon spirits

1- There are angels over governments- Mat 4:8; 2 Cor 4:4; Dan 10:13

b-There are angels that are leaders over other as in the description of the king Abbadon that rules the army of angels in Rev 9:11

c- The four angels bound in the river Euphrates has an army of 200 million horsemen Rev 9:15

4- There are those that are bound and this that are free

a- bound- rev 9:11; 2pet 2:4; 3:19

b- rev 12:7-12; eph. 6:11

5- They attack men

a- make war on the saints 2 Cor 4:4; Eph 4:11

b- can harass the saints 2 Cor 12:7
