Redemption class 3

Padah

Ex 13:11 And it shall be when the Lord shall bring thee into the land of the Canaanites, as he sware unto thee and to thy fathers, and shall give it thee, 12 That thou shalt set apart unto the Lord all that openeth the matrix, and every firstling that cometh of a beast which thou hast; the males shall be the Lord's. 13 And every firstling of an ass thou shalt redeem with a lamb; and if thou wilt not redeem it, then thou shalt break his neck: and all the firstborn of man among thy children shalt thou redeem.

Common in Dueteronomy

&1 When the Lord thy God shall bring thee into the land whither thou goest to possess it, and hath cast out many nations before thee, the Hittites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than thou; 2 And when the Lord thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, and utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor shew mercy unto them: 3 Neither shalt thou make marriages with them: thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son. 4 For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the Lord be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly. 5 But thus shall ye deal with them; ye shall destroy their altars, and break down their images, and cut down their groves, and burn their graven images with fire, 6 For thou art an holy people unto the Lord thy God; the Lord thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth. 7 The Lord did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all people: 8 But because the Lord loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the Lord brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. 9 Know therefore that the Lord thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations; 10 And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face. 11 Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them.

9:26 I prayed therefore unto the Lord, and said, O Lord God, destroy not thy people and thine inheritance, which thou hast redeemed through thy greatness, which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand.

13:5 ...the Lord your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt, and redeemed you out of the house of bondage,...

1Sam 14:24... The story of Jonathan being redeemed by the people; vs 45 So the people rescued (*padah*) Jonathan, that he died not.

2Sam 4:9 (David reminds men he was redeemed by God)

2Sam 7:23 And what one nation in the earth is like thy people, even like Israel, whom God went to redeem (*padah*) for a people to himself, and to make him a name, and to do for you great things and terrible, for thy land, before thy people, which thou redeemedst (*padah*) to thee from Egypt, from the nations and their gods? (David) (Echoed in 1Chr 17:23)

Neh 1:10 Now these are thy servants and thy people, whom thou hast redeemed by thy great power, and by thy strong hand.

Ps 25:22; 26:11; **31:5**; 34:22; 44:26; 49:7, 15; 55:18; 69:18; 71:23; 78:42; 119:134 (deliver); 130:8

Psalm 31:5 Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O Lord God of truth.

Isa 1:27; 29:22; 35:10 (ransomed); 51:11 Therefore the redeemed of the Lord shall return, and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away.

Jer 15:21; **Hosea 7:13**; 13:14; Mic 6:4; Zech 10:8 Like Hosea 13:14 both primary words are used in Jer 31:11

Jer 31:11 For the Lord hath redeemed (padah) Jacob, and ransomed (ga-al) him from the hand of him that was stronger than he.

peduth; H6304 (4 times); distinction, division, redemption (From H6929 precedence)

Ex 8:23; Ps 111:9; 130:7; Isa 50:2 Isa 50:2; redeem; *peduth* H6304

kopher Ransom H3724; (17 times) A payment, translated pitch on the ark and money for a ransom payment

Ps 49:7 None of them can by any means redeem (padah) his brother, nor give to God a ransom (kopher) for him:

pidyom; H6306 (5 times) ransom; redeemed Ex 21:30; Num 3:49, 5; Ps 49:8

deliver natsal H5337 (213 times) defend, deliver, recover, rescue
